To that end, we have developed these policies and protocols: All, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a mask (covering mouth and nose) throughout the building. Distancing should be maintained. Hand sanitizer will be available. Anyone experiencing symptoms or recently exposed to Covid-19 should not attend and will be eligible for a ticket exchange or refund. Vaccination, or a recent negative Covid-19 test, is strongly encouraged.
